He also explained benefits of having a separate A1 and C2 opposed to creating a new class of license for Kelley Williamson. Manager Cook also advised the Commission that if this is approved, the Village Code would also require updating to amend the amount of available C2 Liquor licenses to from one to two.

Background:

The Liquor Control Commission is charged with the administration of laws pertaining to the sale of alcoholic liquors within the Village and has the authority to grant, suspend, and/or revoke alcoholic liquor licenses in accordance with applicable law. Local code establishes the Liquor Control Commission shall conduct an annual meeting to review applications on the third Monday of April of each calendar year to perform its duties. Following is a description of applications submitted to renew existing liquor licenses. The Liquor Control Commission is authorized to review and approve the applications without further action.

Nine liquor license renewal applications were received for the period of May 1, 2022, through April 30, 2023. The applications and supporting documentation were reviewed by staff and appear to be in order.

The applications and supporting documents are on file with the Village Clerk for review by the Commission. Renewal of the following liquor licenses and supplementary licenses as applied, are recommended for FY23.

104 Pingree Grove, LLC d/b/a Hart's Garage – Class B

Renewal application for a Class B liquor license and supplemental licenses. Total fees collected: \$3,000 – Class B liquor license \$1,500.00; supplemental licenses for five (5) video gaming terminals \$1250; and outdoor seating \$250. All renewal application paperwork is in order and on file.
