



### Order of the President

WHEREAS, the Village of Pingree Grove has previously made an emergency declaration pursuant to applicable Village Code and Illinois Law, as Village Ordinance 2020-O-08; and,

WHEREAS, the Village wishes to minimize the potential threat to public health while also taking actions to enable and support the conduct of lawful commerce within its corporate limits; and,

WHEREAS, the Village seeks to support the availability of services to residents while avoiding unreasonable or unnecessary exposure;

Be it Ordered as Follows:

1. This Order incorporates by reference the findings of the Governor of the State of Illinois in support of the Governor's Executive Orders 2020-03 through 2020-10.
2. Based upon the unreasonable risk of potential transmission of Coronavirus / COVID-19 that is posed by the activity of commercial solicitors going from door to door in the residential neighborhoods of the Village, thus having immediate contact with door handles and other common surfaces at large numbers of households, and attempting to initiate face-to-face contact with home occupants in violation of current health recommendations, any currently issued permits for commercial solicitation are hereby suspended, effective immediately. Further, there shall be a prohibition on the issuance of any further commercial solicitation permits until the termination of the present state of emergency.
3. In addition, any retail establishment within the Village that currently maintains a Village-issued liquor license that permits the consumption of alcohol on premises shall be permitted to engage in the package sale of alcohol beverages, as follows:
  - a. Only sales of beer or wine shall be permitted.
  - b. Such items shall be sold in the original, sealed container.
  - c. All other regulations applicable to the sale of alcohol (including age restrictions) shall remain in full force and effect.
  - d. No consumption of such alcohol shall be permitted on premises, as such on-premises consumption would be in violation of the currently existing statewide prohibitions.
